Footnotes

JESTER'S COURT settled off the early pace about the three path, moved to the front past the five sixteenths pole, raced clear nearing the final turn, came under a drive at the head of the lane and kept to steady handling to maintain. MISTY'S SONG stalked the pace two deep, bid leaving the three eighths pole, leveled off in the stretch but lasted for place. SPLASH OF CASH raced well back inside, made a mild bid passing the three eighths pole, eased out rounding the final turn, entered the stretch in the five path and was gaining slowly on place in an even finish. VANESSAK, unhurried off the rail, made a mild bid approaching the quarter pole though had little further in the lane. GINNY RAE accelerated clear approaching the first turn, rated the pace inside to the seven sixteenths pole, was pressured toward the three eighths, yielded near the quarter then faded on the final turn. RUTLEDGE CK WRITER was no factor outside. BONNYGREEN was through after a half mile. KASABLANCA EXPRESS raced well back and never factored.
