Footnotes

WHY SHIRLEY WHY settled off the pace while racing four wide, advanced four wide around the far turn, rallied outside through the lane, took the lead near the sixteenth pole and pulled clear under left-handed urging. GARMENTO stalked the pace inside early, angled two wide nearing the second turn, took the lead leaving the five-sixteenths pole, drew clear midway around the far turn, led to midstretch and held for the place. ROCKTHENITEAWAY stalked the pace two and three wide and was one-paced in the lane. CHRISTMAS HOLLADAY lagged along the inside, swung five wide midway around the far turn and rallied belatedly. DASHING MAX saved ground and failed to menace. TED'S VISION set the pace along the rail, was collared near the five-sixteenths pole and tired around the far turn. J P'S FLING was not a threat while racing three and four wide. DEFINITE HUMOR raced three wide and never factored.
