Footnotes

BANNER YIELD settled close about the four path, gave chase nearing the five sixteenths pole, took over three wide midway on the final turn, drew clear entering the stretch and kept to steady handling to widen. TINSMAN, well back from the early pace inside, eased out from the nine sixteenths pole to improve his position through the backstretch, started a bid near the quarter pole and finished well for place. SKEETER'S CASTLE rated with the pace two two deep past the seven sixteenths pole, pressured the early leader from the five sixteenths pole, dueled to a brief slim lead between horses into the final turn, gave chase from that point but leveled off in the lane. THE LAST BRO, well back toward the inside, eased out with a bid past the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn three wide and finished evenly. IMGOINGTOSMOKEYOU rated a short lead inside, was pressured from the five sixteenths pole, caught past the quarter then weakened approaching the head of the lane. LOOKINATDBRITESIDE settled back about the four path and lacked a significant response on the backstretch. MOHENJO DARO, off the pace inside, faded through the backstretch. FIRST ADMIRAL, unprepared at the start, drifted outward into the first turn.
