**Footnotes**

MY REWARD rated off the pace toward the inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, took aim midway on the final turn, had the lead nearing the top of the stretch, drew clear from there and held well with steady handling. LYR settled back off the rail, bid near the three eighths pole, took place in the upper stretch, finished well and was gaining slowly on the winner. FEISTY ANGELINA drew off to rate a long lead, was pressured from the quarter pole, caught approaching the head of the lane and leveled off. LITTLE MARIE well back from the early leaders outside, gave chase past the half mile pole, improved in the four path of the final turn then leveled off down the stretch. INDIAN SUGAR, well back saving ground, was blocked at the heels of Glenorie through the final turn, eased three wide into the lane but proved empty from there. SUCCULENT SCORE was outrun. HIDDEN BLUFF was not a factor. GLENORIE settled off the pace off the rail, gave chase from the three eighths pole then faded nearing the final turn. IMPERIAL MOMENT saved ground.
