DANCING DEER set the early pace three wide, dropped back around the turn then came again drive. FLIGHT OPS saved ground, rallied three wide on the turn, closed with a rush. BIG BAD SALLY advanced three and four wide but failed to sustain her bid. RINKA BELL failed to menace, four and five wide. BACKSTAGE stalked the pace four wide, failed to respond. VERSATILES SECRET saved ground to no avail. DEBBIE'S GONE hard used inside, tired. ROCK'D EM ALL had brief foot three wide. JUICY FRUITS a pace factor for a half, had little left for the drive.
