MOONLIT MALIBU set a leisurely pace inside the opening half mile, prompted midway on the final turn, was under a drive entering the stretch and held steadfast. SPRING JUMP stalked the pace off the rail, took aim past the five sixteenths pole and continued a close stretch factor though needed more late. SHEFOGGEDMYGLASSES settled well back of the early pace inside, eased toward the outside entering the backstretch, progressed from the three eighths pole, entered the stretch about the five path and finished well. GRAND KISSES rated close inside, was pressured toward the three eighths pole then leveled off near the rail down the lane. DECO ROCKS, five wide the opening turn, settled just off the pace about the four path on the backstretch, was urged from the five sixteenths pole though leveled off in the stretch. STAGED AFFAIR, off the pace inside, showed no response on the final turn. WILD KAY raced boxed between horses at the heels of Spring Jump approaching the first turn, made a mild bid off the rail down the backstretch but had nothing further in the lane.
