ELIZABETH LANE pressed the pace off the rail, took over from the pacesetter midstretch and lasted under steady encouragement. BECKY B chased the pace toward the outside, was carried wider leaving the turn and finished well while dueling for place. RUN PAIGE RUN chased the pace toward the outside, was carried out leaving the turn then outfinished in the duel for place. SHE'S HOT STUFF chased the pace off the rail, drifted out leaving the turn and finished evenly. SPEAKING OF LUCK, well back saving ground, bid toward the quarter pole and finished well near the rail. MATTAPONI chased the pace from the inside, brushed the rail approaching the turn then leveled off down the lane. GREAT CURVES was shuffled back near the rail approaching the turn. HOPE FOR A WIN pulled clear to set a pressured pace just off the rail, was asked for more leaving the turn, bobbled in the upper stretch, was immediately pulled up, appeared lame and was vanned off.
