Footnotes

PAGAN CAT settled back inside, advanced along the rail from the half mile pole, eased outward rounding the final turn, was in tight four wide at the top of the lane but dug in under determined handling to get up the final yards. RUMMY'S COMMAND raced well back of the early pace off the rail, bid leaving the three eighths pole, took over three wide midway on the final turn, dueled gamely from the head of the lane but grudgingly yielded the closing yards. BLUES IN THE NIGHT, unhurried outside, bid toward the five sixteenths pole, came through the final turn six wide, closed for show in midstretch and finished evenly. ANOTHER OREO settled back about the three path, started a four wide drive nearing the quarter pole, was carried five wide entering the stretch then leveled off from the sixteenth pole. HE'S A PRIZE, well back outside, bid toward the quarter pole and passed tiring rivals. JOYFUL KISS stalked the pace off the rail, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole, dueled to a slim lead past the quarter pole, was quickly overcome but remained a close factor to midstretch before weakening. CLARKE COUNTY settled off the early pace about the three path, gave chase from the three eighths pole but lacked further on the final turn. TOUGH TALKING was not a factor. HENRY THE LOVER rated the pace inside, came under pressure from the five sixteenths pole, contested the rail through the final turn then weakened in the stretch. GOLD STANDARD became fractious in the gate, nearly flipping over then never factored.
