HONORABLE HALO set the pace four wide and prevailed while kept to strong urging. PANCHO'S PRIDE moved up along the inside to be second best. RETRIEVE THE GOLD altered out wide around turn when SHINING ANGEL bore out, finished well six wide. JUDGE BRANDY bobbled at the start, was taken wide down the backstretch, gained some ground through the stretch. SHINING ANGEL bore out into the turn forcing several rivals to alter course then fell back. CALL HOME ETBAUER close up inside, came three wide around the turn, lacked a late response. ASTRONIC was checked and forced wide around the turn, dropped back thereafter. SLOW DANCIN steadied into the turn off heels, faded and was vanned off after the finish. STORMY MUSIC saved ground to no avail.
