NAY'S TAP forced the issue four wide, took command in upper stretch and inched away under a steady drive. GREEN SUEDE SHOES dueled inside of LORD OF THE DANCE to upper stretch, brushed with that rival near the eighth pole and continued gamely to the wire to save the place. LORD OF DANCE vied outside of GREEN SUEDE SHOES for the advantage, brushed with that rival near the eighth pole and was outfinished in the lane. BLUES IN THE NIGHT was unhurried early, gained ground while racing three wide around the turn, rallied belatedly in the lane. TROUBLE MAKIN was fastest into stride, prompted the pace three wide, could not keep pace leaving the three-sixteenths pole. PERFECT WAY was never a factor. MOTHER FREEDOM was never a threat while racing four wide. VIRGINIA REBEL was off slow, quickly taken five wide and never got involved.
