Footnotes

COCO COBANA chased the pace toward mid track and dug in five wide from the top of the stretch to get up the final yards. MISS SARAH BROWN accelerated to the front near the three eighths pole, urged clear into the turn, was under steady stretch encouragement but caught in the final yards. RIGHT CREDENTIALS led the opening three sixteenths, gave chase from the three eighths pole and finished evenly while needing more. INDY TECH chased the pace from the inside and finished evenly. NASHI chased the pace from the outside, rounded the turn about the four path and showed only mild improvement through the lane. MAX'S RUNNER gave brief close early chase toward mid track but showed little in the stretch. LATIKA chased the pace toward the outside, rounded the turn in the five path and leveled off in the stretch. FIRST COLONY raced well back off the rail, came through the turn about the five path and had no rally. MARTHA'S YANKEE saved ground well back.
