Footnotes

SIR PRIZE came in and bumped WOODYS A GOODIE into QUICK SHOW at the start, stalked the pace inside around the first turn, advanced two wide around the far turn, could not gain through midstretch then surged late and was up in the final strides. INDIGO MONTOYA disputed the pace three wide, drew clear nearing the far turn, set a clear pace near the rail around the far turn, held clear to deep stretch and led until the final strides. WOODYS A GOODIE was bumped into QUICK SHOW just after the start, lacked speed while racing two wide early, advanced four wide between foes around the far turn and rallied through the lane. CALLING CLYDE lacked speed while racing four wide around the first turn, advance inside around the far turn and was out kicked in the lane. KOKO KEY settled off the pace while racing three wide, raced along the rail around the far turn and had a mild rally. QUICK SHOW was bumped just after the start, lagged in three path early, circled five and six wide around the far turn and flattened out a bit in the lane. CLICKIT OR TRICKIT chased the pace two wide and faded four wide around the far turn. PINCH THIS TOO set the pace in the two path and tired while trying to get out around the far turn.
