COYA pressed the issue three wide, made a clear lead on the turn, prevailed while kept to strong urging. CASSE saved ground, rallied three wide around the turn, closed with a rush through the lane. SACRED FEATHER set the pace under heavy pressure, gave way around the turn. LONG TIME GONE prompted the issue three and four wide, lacked a late response. HANAIEI BAY within striking distance three wide, dropped to the rail on the turn, lacked a late response. CELESTIAL PRINCESS failed to menace, three and four wide. PHYL'S NOTEBOOK broke in a tangle, made little impact five wide. MISS ARTIC NIGHT forced the pace along the rail, pulled up on the turn then was vanned off after the finish.
