Footnotes

SALTY TEMPER settled off the pace inside, bid nearing the three eighths pole, moved alongside the top two three wide midway on the final turn, took a slim lead entering the stretch, dropped back past the eighth pole but dug in under steady urging to recover clear territory in later yards. MR. MAC'S COLLEEN rated a short lead inside, was pressured past the three eighths pole, briefly gave up the advantage leaving the final turn, recovered control past the eighth pole and kept the edge to deep stretch before yielding to the winner. ANTHENSOME rated close to the early pace off the rail, pressured the runner-up past the three eighths pole, raced at even terms while between horses in the upper stretch but reluctantly yielded and was outfinished in the duel for place. PROVERBIAL, pinched at the start, settled back about the three path, started a bid near the rail leaving the half mile pole then leveled out down the lane. KIND HEARTED WOMAN broke out making contact with Proverbial, stalked the early pace about the three path, gave chase leaving the half mile pole then faded approaching the final turn. X F BUCKLES settled close about the four path then faded from the half mile pole. MINERS BLUES raced well back and was no factor. ROYAL CIRCUS, five wide the first two turns, moved to stalking position four wide past the half mile pole but faded from there. COACH CRAWFORD came in making contact with Proverbial leaving the gate, stalked the early pace two deep but faded from the nine sixteenths pole.
