TWENTY HAWKS stalked the pace two deep, challenged for control leaving the half mile pole, contested at a slim disadvantage through the final turn but dug in under a determined stretch drive to take the nod in late strides. WORKING MAN BLUES rated a short lead off the rail, was prompted from the half mile pole, contested a slight advantage at the rail rounding the final turn, dug in gamely with the edge from the head of the lane but gave up the nod the closing strides. SMOKE THE DEVIL settled close off the rail, started a bid leaving the half mile pole, entered the stretch three wide and stayed on gamely to the wire. LIAM'S SONG settled close inside, gave chase past the three eighths pole but leveled off through the lane. T. M.'S TREASURE settled at the back of the pack outside, bid saving ground past the three eighths pole, angled out entering the stretch but leveled off through the lane.
