CREDIT GAL saved ground, was shuffled back down the backstretch, rallied four wide around the turn, gained the lead in late stretch. NAN'S ROSE stalked the pace on the rail, bid three wide around the turn, closed with a rush through the lane. SISTY ANNE alternated on the lead for a half, gained clear lead on the turn and finished gamely. BLOOMIN JUSTICE prompted the pace three wide, lacked a closing bid. HARD GAL B alternated on the lead for a half, weakened in the drive. BROKER'S BONUS failed to menace, five wide. CASTELLI'S GYPSY forced the pace four and five wide, lacked the needed rally. T. V. SECRETARY never was a factor, six wide. POLISH MARY five wide along the backstretch, dropped to the rail on the turn then was no threat in the drive.
