LUCY'S BOB BOY pressed the pace three wide through the opening six furlongs, took the lead leaving the three-eighths pole, angled to the rail soon after, quickly drew off around the far turn and widened at will under moderate urging in the lane. RUSSELL ROAD settled just off the pace while racing three wide between foes, was boxed in down the backstretch, had clear run from the five-sixteenths pole, raced two wide between rivals around the far turn, was no match for the winner but finished gamely to earn the place. ALLEGHENY JACK set a pressured pace along the rail, vied inside on a slight disadvantage down the backstretch, could not keep pace with the winner from the three-eighths pole, dueled inside of foes for the place through the lane and held for the show. SON OF A BEAR stalked the pace four wide, was no match for the winner entering the far turn, chased three wide around that bend to take second turning for home but was outfinished for the minor awards. RUMMY'S COMMAND was unhurried while racing five wide around the first turn and four wide around the clubhouse turn, continued four wide around the far turn and improved his position. FRED HIGH bumped with SEA RESCUE just after the start, lacked speed while racing four wide, went five wide around the far turn and failed to menace. BLACK BELT steadied along around the first turn, stalked the pace inside and came up empty around the far turn. LIVELY REPARATIONS settled off the pace while racing two wide, raced three wide around the far turn and lacked a rally. FIGPENN pressed the pace two wide between rivals, took the lead near the half-mile pole, dueled between down the backstretch and tired around the far turn. SEA RESCUE was bumped just after the start, lacked speed along the rail, raced three wide around the clubhouse turn, saved ground around the far turn and never factored.
