Footnotes

BAY OF BULLS off a step slow, rushed up three wide, moved clear on the turn then widened under urging. SLOW AND STEADY prompted the pace five wide down the backstretch, came three wide around the turn but lacked a late bid. COMPELLING FANTASY bid five wide on the turn to be best of the others. FLIGHT OPS five wide along the backstretch, rallied along the rail on the turn but failed to sustain her bid. LOST FLAMINGO was no factor three and four wide. DAMARISCOTTA close up, had no rally. CATE'S MY ANGEL sluggish at the start, had little impact. FOREVER LUCK stalked the pace four wide, had little left for the drive. CALAMIAMINE set the early pace, gave way around the turn and was not abused through the stretch.
