COASTAL DRIVE saved ground, rallied four wide around the turn to reach contention then under a strong drive was up in the final strides. SILENCE BREAKER gained a slim lead down the backstretch, drew off around the turn, led until the final strides. LOVE TOUR prompted the issue just off the rail, rallied on the turn and finished strongly. FAMOUS FROLIC tardy at the start, was six wide down the backstretch, eased down four wide around the turn, lacked a late bid. DES ARTISTES off a step slow, made a run five wide along the backstretch, flattened out. SHADOW WAVE showed little, four wide. SKYCROSSING forced the pace four wide then was used up after a half. GONE RACIN set the early pace along the inside, dug in down the backstretch, had little left for the drive.
