SPRINGS ROAD broke well from between foes to stalk the early pace, inched closer up the backstretch, responded to pressure entering the second turn, gained command and was never roused as much the best. IN THE SPOTLIGHT stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced up the backstretch, responded but was no match for the winner. MAJOR DANGER well placed from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, made a bid but could not sustain the effort. GATEWAY MOON chased the early pace outside but had nothing left. GRAND ASSASSIN well placed from the outside, had no late response. PASCO GETTLE was no factor. WEST VIRGINIA WIND had a steady fade. ASK THE PRICE was no threat. POLITICAL REPORTER was never close. MAN OF LA MANCHA dueled from the inside early and gave way.
