GOLD SCORE stalked the pace two wide between rivals, rallied through the lane, took command in deep stretch and edged away under moderate urging. AL N CON set the pace along the rail, drifted three wide into the lane, was collared late but held well for the place. WHAT A PRINCE stalked the pace three deep around the turn, lacked a rally while racing between rivals through the stretch and won the bob for the show. FROLIC ON HOME was bumped just after the start, raced four wide around the turn, swung to the far outside nearing the lane, rallied and just missed third. HOMBRE was washy pre-race, chased the pace four wide, angled in near the three-sixteenths pole, vied inside of foes for third through the lane and just missed. WHITEHOUSE RIDGE bumped with FROLIC ON HOME soon after the start and was no further factor while saving ground. MR. COMMISSIONER was outrun while racing five wide. NICE CASE chased the pace inside while appearing to try to get out early, was getting in and climbing nearing the turn, came out leaving the quarter pole, was eased soon after, walked across the wire, appeared sore and walked off.
