**Footnotes**

DANCING FIGHTER was checked entering the first turn, raced off the pace two wide through the opening six furlongs, advanced four wide around the far turn, closed determinedly and was up in the final strides. RASCAL CAT stalked the pace from the rail, moved three wide to the lead midway down the backstretch, drew clear near the five-sixteenths pole, held clear in the two path to deep stretch and led until the final strides. TEA TOTT pressed the pace two wide, took the lead leaving the half-mile pole, chased inside around the far turn and weakened while holding third. STEADY EDDIE lacked speed while racing four wide early, saved some ground around the clubhouse turn, went three wide around the far turn, loomed boldly nearing the lane and flattened out. KINGPOST bobbled and was bumped just after the start, saved ground around the first turn, steadied then angled four wide nearing the wire the first turn, raced three wide around the second turn, chased inside around the far turn and lacked the needed rally. WHY BILL WHY failed to menace while racing three and four wide. WILD CAPTAIN BOB was bumped just after the start, moved four to the lead around the first turn, set the pace along the rail and faded after a half. THE PACK IS BACK was outrun while racing four and five wide. BIG JIMMY J. had brief speed three wide.
