Footnotes

WILD PEAK moved to contention five wide approaching the first turn, kept close to the lead outside on the backstretch, made a bid nearing the quarter pole, drew aim at the top of the lane and dug in from there to eke out the win in the final strides. BIG AND BRIGHT bore out at the start, took a brief early lead inside before stalking the pace near the rail, gave chase from the three eighths pole, dueled to the lead a furlong away and dug in gamely to the final strides before grudgingly ceding. ROCK OUT, bumped at the start, rated off the pace inside, bid nearing the quarter pole, eased out rounding the final turn, entered the stretch five wide and finished well. JJALAD, bumped at the start, settled well back toward the outside, made a bid from the three eighths pole, came through the final turn five wide and finished well. ALLEN'S MONSTER moved to the lead leaving the five eighths pole, rated clear through the backstretch, was urged from the five sixteenths pole, yielded control at the head of the lane and gave way a few strides later. CHARMING SAWYER was bumped outward and into Rock Out leaving the gate, chased the pace from the inside through the backstretch then leveled out in the lane. BRADDOCK STREET, pinched back at the start, was not a factor. RUTLEDGE LION was bumped and jostled hard at the start, rated close to the early pace three wide though faded nearing the final turn. A. P. BEST broke in making sharp contact with Rutledge Lion and was no factor afterward. HESITANT GROOM was kept close to the early pace four wide but started to fade from the three eighths pole.
