Footnotes

DIVINE PLAN unhurried early while between foes, steadily advanced up the backstretch while outside rivals, reached a striking position entering the third turn, responded when sat down for the drive and inched clear late. CHALICE BEARER stalked the early going from the inside, advanced up the rail entering the backstretch, gained a short advantage entering the third turn but could not keep pace with the winner through the drive. SHAKY'S PRIZE allowed to settle early, advanced outside entering the third turn, responded to pressure and finished well. CHARISMATIC KALI dueled from the inside for the early lead, gained a clear margin up the backstretch but tired in the drive. THE COLOR RED went evenly. FILLYPINO chased the early pace from the inside and tired. BI ROSE was never close. ATTENTION DEFICIT dueled from the outside and gave way.
