MAXIMUM PLAN up close early from the inside, dropped back up the backstretch, altered outside entering the second turn, engaged the leaders entering the drive, dueled with those and was clear the final furlong under steady urging. YOU ARE OUT dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged with LITTLEBROTHER ALEX up the backstretch, remained in a battle through the drive but could not match strides. LITTLEBROTHER ALEX dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, dueled through the drive but could not keep pace. ALY RAJA well placed from between foes, dropped to the rail entering the drive and finished well. I'M NOT A BABY far back early, altered outside entering the second turn, responded and was gaining late. IM A TIGGER TOO was no factor. VIRGINIA HERO chased the early pace and tired. ANNEX FEED pressed the early pace from between foes, remained forward entering the second turn and tired in the drive. DELAWARE DIAMOND was no threat. DEEPINMYPOCKETS was always outrun.
