Footnotes

I'M NOT A BABY settled off the pace in the two path early, angled four wide nearing the clubhouse turn, advanced outside down the backstretch, moved three wide around the far turn to take the lead nearing the lane then drew off under mild stretch encouragement. SILVER SLUGGER stalked the pace three wide through the opening six furlongs, bid two wide between rivals around the far turn, could not keep pace with the winner in upper stretch but finished willingly for the place. I GOT'M lagged well back along the inside, angled out in upper stretch and rallied for the show. GAMBERONI set the pace along the rail, continued on his left lead in the lane and tired. BAKHOOR pressed the pace two wide, retreated around the far turn and appeared sore upon return. CASH SALE raced four wide around the first turn, angled to the rail the first time through the stretch, angled back out to the four path entering the far turn and tired.
