Footnotes

FIRST UP stalked the early pace from the inside, took over nearing the five eighths pole, was pressured from the three eighths and dug in under steady stretch encouragement to last. MANNY MAN settled off the early pace inside, bid off the rail leaving the half mile pole, steadily progressed to second midway on the final turn and was gaining on the winner nearing the wire. KYRIE ELEISON FA, off the pace toward the outside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn five wide but leveled off down the lane. SPECIAL MUSIC rated off the pace inside, bid nearing the seven sixteenths pole, raced at the rail rounding the final turn and finished evenly. Q DAWG, well back off the rail, started a bid leaving the three eighths pole then leveled out down the lane. ROLL THAT WAY, well back outside, bid approaching the five sixteenths pole then leveled off down the lane. VALENTINE SECRET rated a short lead off the rail, was caught approaching the five eighths pole, gave chase leaving the half pole then faded on the final turn and lost ground into the lane. SWEET REP was no factor toward the outside. CRAFTY QUOIT rated close about the four path, bid nearing the seven sixteenths pole but weakened rounding the final turn. THE FARTHA HE GOES, off the pace toward mid track, weakened nearing the final turn.
