VAGUE NOTION stalked the early pace from the inside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive, gained the advantage and steadily drew clear. NICOLES PROSPECT dueled from the outside for the early lead, dueled up the backstretch, remained forward entering the drive but could not match strides. CAMP SAGINAW dueled from the inside for the early lead, dueled up the backstretch, remained in a striking position entering the drive but could not keep pace. BIMINI BAY chased the early pace inside, made a bid entering the drive and had a mild late gain. DELAWARE DIAMOND could only improve position. DUSTIN MILLIE could only pass tired ones. PAID PREVIEW forced the pace from the inside but had nothing left. AFLEETS PLEASURE was no factor. PLANE IMAGE had a steady fade. POLITICAL REPORTER was outrun. Final time and split times were hand timed for this race.
