Footnotes

MR. RIPKEN rated a slim lead inside, widened through the final turn and dug in under hardy stretch encouragement to hold on. GOLDEN STYLE saved ground off the pace, bid past the five sixteenths pole, dug in to take late aim but needed a bit more. WINDSOR'S TWIST, off the pace toward mid track, bid nearing the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn five wide and finished evenly for show. GULF SHORES, well back off the rail, bid leaving the half mile pole and improved to the top of the stretch before leveling off. TUTUOLA raced well back outside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn in the six path and passed tiring rivals. STERLING'S WARRIOR gave chase about the three path then leveled off on the final turn. DICK'S TERMS was not a factor. BEE LINE DRIVE accelerated to a brief slim early lead near the three quarter pole, stayed with the winner two deep to the five sixteenths pole, readily faded rounding the final turn and appeared to be sore upon return. TIKI BAR saved ground racing well back.
