FANCY DAN advanced three wide, made the lead on the turn, prevailed under urging. GREEN SUEDE SHOES set the pace on the rail and while no threat to the winner was clearly second best. DR. BARCH moved up three and four wide but was no match for the top two. BLACKHOSSNAMDWHITY prompted the issue three wide, lacked a late response. HUDSON within striking distance three and four wide, lacked a late bid. THE REAL SEAL never threatened on the rail. HE'S INCREDIBLE was no factor, five wide. PUNK ROBINSON was used up after a half, three and four wide. JUDGE MARSHALL stalked the pace on the rail, tired. FAX AMATIC bore out at the start, rushed up to press the pace, had little left after a half.
