TITAN ALEXANDER, well back off the rail, bid leaving the half mile pole, eased four wide rounding the final turn, dug in from the head of the lane to take the lead in deep stretch and was inching ahead toward the wire. HURRICANE BAY settled just off the pace about the three path, started a bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, dueled to a slim lead approaching the head of the lane and held the advantage to late stretch before grudgingly yielding. GREMIO saved some ground approaching the first turn, settled back outside into the backstretch, bid nearing the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn about the three path and finished evenly. LORD GIN rated close inside leaving the first turn, bid past the three eighths pole, dueled to a slim brief lead in mid turn but dropped back entering the stretch and leveled off. DERBY WINE, bumped outward into the opening turn, dropped well back outside, gave chase leaving the half mile pole, rounded the final turn about the four path and passed tiring rivals. FRUITCAKE was brushed and bobbled a stride from the gate and through early. LETME SERANADE YOU was bumped in and into Fruitcake leaving the gate, rated the pace off the rail, came under pressure past the three eighths pole, caught midway on the final turn then gave way from the head of the lane. TUFF ACTION came away awkwardly making contact with Letme Serenade You and was through after three eighths. ALONZAVILLE was roughed when boxed at the heels of Gremio approaching the first turn, ran out bumping Derby Wine into the turn and was not a factor.
