**Footnotes**

HERTZEL bumped with SUNDAY SERVICE just after the start, vied between foes down the backstretch, drew clear in the two path around the turn and widened under urging in the lane. SERGEANT SKI chased the pace three wide and finished willingly for the place. WINNERTAKESITALL chased the pace outside down the backstretch, angled in near the five-sixteenths pole, chased the pace from the rail around the turn and weakened a bit while continuing on his left lead in the lane. GINGERBREAD FRED was bumped after the start, checked off WINNERTAKESITALL'S heels near the five-sixteenths pole, raced two wide into the turn, angled four wide leaving the three-sixteenths pole and had a mild rally. D'SMARTY CAT disputed the pace inside of the winner down the backstretch and tired around the turn. STONEWALLING failed to menace while racing three wide. PARKERSDOUBLEDOTS was not a threat while racing three wide. SUNDAY SERVICE bumped with the winner just after the start, bumped with GINGERBREAD FRED a few strides later, raced two wide and was no further factor. PETE'S THUNDER was outrun while racing four wide. JUDGE MARSHALL was outrun while racing three wide. Following an inquiry, the Stewards disqualified WINNERTAKESITALL from third and placed him fourth for interference near the five-sixteenths pole.
