PERILOUS LAD stalked the leaders three wide, bid along the rail on the turn, made the lead nearing the sixteenth pole and drew off. GUTENBERG pressed the issue three wide, had aim into the stretch but was out finished. SCALPER set the pace under heavy pressure, was lugging out mid stretch and weakened. AFTERNOON JAZZ prompted the issue three wide, lacked a late response. MR. JEFFERSON five wide down the backstretch, eased down three wide on the turn, lacked a closing bid. PROUD AIR REQUEST never threatened, three and four wide. THIS BULLS TUSLICK made little impact, three wide. FORTY IN A DAY five wide along the backstretch, was no factor. OWEN MONEY failed to menace on the rail. THEATRICALCOMOTION bore out then steadied at the start, always was outrun.
