HILLARY'S HARBOR stalked the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, dueled with SPUNKETTE through the drive, gained a short advantage deep stretch then just lasted late. PETULANT well placed from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive, responded when asked and was getting to the winner. SPUNKETTE broke sharp from between foes to gain a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, dueled with the winner through the drive but could not keep pace. RHYTHM N RED chased the early pace from the inside, altered outside entering the second turn, responded and finished well but too late. A SHOT AND A MINT pressed the early pace from between foes but had nothing left for the drive. HEY U chased the early pace from the inside and tired. NAT'S MY KISS was no factor. THE FIDDLERS GIRL forced the early pace from the outside but gave way.
