Footnotes

WOODYS A GOODIE was sent from the gate, set a clear pace in the two path and held clear under a drive. MAIN MAN SAM bobbled and was bumped just after the start, was devoid of speed while racing two and three wide around the first two turns, began to advance three wide around the far turn and closed strongly through the lane. SOUL OF THE WEST lacked speed along the inside, quickly advanced between rivals down the backstretch, chased the winner from the rail around the far turn and flattened out in the lane. POSTMAN PETE settled off the pace while racing three and four wide and came up empty. FOXFIELD DRIVE saved ground and tired. REDHEADEDSTEPCHILD bumped with MAIN MAN SAM just after the start, stalked the pace in the three path and tired around the far turn. CALL OF FAME steadily faded while racing four and five wide. E. T. MOON raced wide, stopped and was eased. EMBRACE THE ROCK had brief speed between rivals, stopped after a half and was eased.
