PURELY BUSINESS was hustled along inside to set the pace the opening turn, remained forwardly placed through the backstretch while alternating for the lead, contested a disadvantage rounding the final turn but recovered control a furlong away and dug in under an all out drive to just last. WINDSOR CITY, unhurried well back and inside, bid angling outward on the final turn, entered the stretch in the six path, closed with a rush and just missed. ROYAL EAVESDROPPER rated with the pace three wide, dueled to a slim lead at the quarter pole and held the advantage through the final turn, ceded control at the top of the lane then leveled off toward the wire. UNSHATTERABLE, unhurried off the rail, bid from the three eighths pole, advanced along the rail rounding the final turn and ran evenly through the lane. BOB BOB'S BOY broke through the gate prior the start, rated close to the early pace inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, eased four wide rounding the final turn and finished evenly. SAFARI HEART drifted outward into the opening turn, raced well back outside, entered the stretch eight wide and weakened from there. PASCO GETTLE was not a factor. LION ON THE MOON rated close to the early pace two deep, gave chase through the backstretch though had nothing further on the final turn. AISLE SWAGGA broke through the gate prior the start and was through early. DYLAN MY VILLAIN stayed with the pace two deep for a half mile then gave way approaching the final turn.
