COUNT BRAHMS wide into the first turn, made a slim lead down the backstretch, drew off thereafter under a drive. FLYING ARTHUR set the early pace, remained a factor until the turn, could not gain on the winner in the drive and was all out to hold second. LIKE A BULL stalked the leaders from the inside, swung out four wide on the turn, finished well through the lane. BLUE MALIBU with the pace three wide, lacked a late response. LIFEGUARD well placed on the rail, failed to respond when asked in the drive. YELLOW BRICK BANK within striking distance three wide, lacked the needed late rally. MY WHIM MY WAY failed to menace along the inside. DRAW THE TAP was used up after a half while three wide. The rider of LIFEGUARD claimed foul against LIKE A BULL alleging interference at the start. The rider of FLYING ARTHUR claimed foul against the winner alleging interference into the last turn. Both claims were dismissed by the Stewards after a review of the video tape replays.
