WILD GOOSE CHASE pressed the pace, drew off on the turn and was ridden out through the stretch. RAGGAAS UPRISING saved ground, angled three wide on the turn then was second best in the drive. THISWOODSFORYOU found her best stride late four wide. BOB'S BABY CLEO well placed, had no rally. BLESSED CONNIE showed early speed then tired. ELLIE'S MISS stalked the pace three and four wide, had no response. APPEALING NORTHROP set the pace along the inside for a half then tired. FIGURE YOUR CHANCE showed little. BRONZE PLUMAGE was no factor.
