JAKE'S MANDATE prompted the issue three wide, gained the lead nearing the sixteenth pole then was all out to last. WILD IRISH ROGUE set the pace under heavy pressure, led until the sixteenth pole. WHAT A WILDCAT stalked the leaders from the inside then was no match for the top two. KNOCKOUT PUNCH pressed the issue just off the rail, lacked a late response. MEGAN'S COWBOY forced the pace three and four wide, lacked a closing bid. FOREST RUNNER was no factor along the inside. JOSEF K made little impact from the inside. LUKE 'N PAPPY went to his nose at the start then failed to menace. CANADIAN CUSTOM showed little along the inside. HAIL TO LOUIE reluctant to load, bore out at the start then never threatened.
