### Footnotes

D D'S BUDDY gained a clear lead down the backstretch while just off the rail, drew off around the turn then held clear through the stretch under steady left handed urging. TOMORROW'S TALE advanced three wide along the backstretch, eased down to the rail on the turn, finished willingly in the drive. STAND UP STAN pressed the pace from the rail, angled three wide for the drive but lacked a closing bid when asked. I'M THE IRISH MAN with the leaders three wide, lacked the needed rally. ZERO POINT ZERO off slow, bore out steadied start, forced pace four wide, lacked late response. MR. DUQUE made little impact on the rail. RUN MONEY RUN saved ground, came four wide around the turn, never threatened in the drive.
