MISTER FIPS (IRE) prompted the issue from the rail, angled out for the drive, gained the lead near the sixteenth pole and drove clear. NAN'S REAL LOVE saved ground, rallied four wide around the turn and finished well. NORTHERN CRUISER set the pace under pressure, led until near the sixteenth pole before weakening. WOMPUM RIDGE pressed the issue three wide, lacked a late response. WE HAVE IGNITION broke awkwardly, advanced four wide but failed to sustain his bid. SNOW CAP within striking distance four and five wide, failed to respond. DEPUTY BOB with the leaders three and four wide, lacked the needed late rally. SOVEREIGN RULER flashed brief foot, five wide. TELL ME WILLIE WIN was no factor, four wide. TAKING OVER broke down along the backstretch.
