Footnotes

GANGA settled back toward mid track, steadily improved his position from the half mile pole, had aim in the upper stretch, dueled to the front at the sixteenth pole and dug in determinedly to hold the edge. GENERAL RUTLEDGE stalked the pace about the three path, bid nearing the quarter pole, took the lead midway on the final turn, drew briefly clear, dug in with the advantage to midstretch then grudgingly yielded in a game effort. REAL QUIET TIME, unhurried off the rail, bid from the five sixteenths pole, angled out making light contact with English Alphabet entering the stretch and finished well. CHRISTMAS HOLLADAY, well back and off the rail, bid from the five sixteenths pole, angled six wide rounding the final turn and finished evenly outside. ENGLISH ALPHABET stalked the pace about the three path, was urged from the five sixteenths pole, forced out and brushed lightly leaving the final turn and leveled off from there. FREE HUMOR moved to the lead inside nearing the eighth pole the first time, rated the pace to the half mile pole, was pressured toward the three eighths, held the advantage to just inside the quarter pole, dueled close to midstretch then weakened. PRIZED FIGHTER, edgy in the gate, settled off the pace toward mid track then faded on the final turn. COMEBACK PAPA was not a factor. INALEAGUEOFMYOWN rated with the pace two deep to the five sixteenths pole then faded on the final turn. NEW MILLENNIUM saved ground.
