MUSIC TOWN quickly established control of the pace, was rated inside to the head of the lane, pressured from there and held well. THUNDER CLAN settled off the pace inside, bid from the seven sixteenths pole, dueled for place in the upper stretch and dug in to retain. BLUE CATILLAC stalked the winner off the rail, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole, was outfinished for place in the upper stretch and leveled off late. LA LA'S COOKIN was roughed on the heels of Music Town through the first turn, eased to the three path to give chase down the backstretch then leveled off in the lane. ESSAY, loose in the post parade, saved ground to no avail. BUSY LISTENING was carried wide entering the first turn and never factored. HOOSIER STAR angled out entering the first turn, gave chase in mid track through the backstretch and showed little further on the final turn. CLASSY COLLECTION raced well back saving ground.
