TIME IS NOW chased the pace from off the rail and dug in under a determined drive to inch ahead the final yards. ABSOLUTE RUSSIAN set a clear early pace inside and dug in gamely with the edge to the final yards before reluctantly ceding. RUN DIXIE chased the pace from the outside, rounded the turn about the five path then drifted inward through the lane while lasting for show. SHARPIE'S SON chased the pace in mid track and passed tired rivals in an even finish. J. R.'S BOY, in tight early, angled outward through the lane and finished evenly outside. LIL MISSILE, off the pace inside, steadied at the rail past the five sixteenths pole then leveled out in the stretch. LUKWHATDACATDRUGIN gave chase after an awkward break then weakened in the stretch. TRI OMEGA chased the pace toward the outside, lost some ground through the turn, entered the stretch about the seven path and weakened from there. CUSTIS dropped well back from the early speed, raced wide and came back bleeding from the nose. SHARK WEEK showed no speed.
