SPEEDY SAMMY stalked the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the turn, engaged TROUBLE MAKIN entering the drive, dueled through the stretch and outfinished that one. TROUBLE MAKIN broke sharp to gain a clear early margin, dueled with the winner through the drive but was outfinished. TUFTON up close early from the inside, made a bid entering the stretch and was gaining late. SHOWMETHETRICK pressed the early pace from the outside, remained forward entering the drive but could not keep pace. SOOTHING BELL could only pass tired ones. NO ATTRACTION could only improve position. BLANCHE'S NARDER had a steady fade. POP'S MOJO was outrun. UNTO CAESAR pressed the early pace from the outside, was pulled up entering the turn and vanned off.
