Footnotes

COUNTRY HELLO rated with the early pace inside, eased off the rail with a bid approaching the five sixteenths pole, moved to the front into the final turn, was urged clear from the three sixteenths pole and widened to easily best the runner-up. LOOKINATDBRITESIDE was hustled to the front to set the pace two deep, inched clear toward the three eighths pole, was caught into the final turn and just lasted for place. PRUFROCK stumbled at the break, settled well back saving ground, bid nearing the five sixteenths pole, finished well and just missed place. OUR DOOR PRIZE, well back inside, started a drive leaving the five sixteenths pole, improved at the rail rounding the final turn and passed tiring rivals. MOYCULLEN, in tight entering the first turn, rated off the pace inside, bid nearing the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn about the four path then leveled off down the lane. D WAG, four wide into the first turn, gave chase off the rail leaving the five eighths pole and stayed in range to the final turn before weakening. WIN THE GREEN kept close to the pace four wide the opening turn, dropped back from the half mile pole and was no further factor. HAROLD T was through early. MOUNTAINEER MANIAC steadied at the heels of Lookinatdbriteside into the first turn, gave chase out of the turn but faded through the backstretch. MARKET SQUARE HERO ran out the first turn then trailed wide.
