Footnotes

BUCKEY ROAD stalked the pace two wide, took the lead three wide near the quarter pole, set the pace three deep around the far turn, vied outside of DSPITE ALL MY RAGE through midstretch and edged ahead while drifting out under left handed urging. DSPITE ALL MY RAGE lacked speed along the inside, moved two wide between foes around the far turn, reached even terms in upper stretch but was outfinished by the winner. BABY TIME settled well off the pace along the inside, advanced four wide around the far turn and finished evenly. BROOKS IN TOWN saved ground and improved his position. DEVIL'S HALL pressed the pace two wide, took the lead near the three-eighths pole and tired around the far turn. CAROLINE'S DANCER failed to menace while racing three wide. SULTRY PROSPECTOR raced three and four wide and had no response. CELTIC HEIR was not a threat while racing four wide. BLACK TIE BOOGIE was outrun while racing three and four wide. LAST OF HIS KIND set the pace along the rail and was done after three-quarters.
