WONDER LITE stalked the early pace from the inside, crept closer up the backstretch, altered outside entering the second turn, responded and was just up the final stride. NEWFY outrun early, advanced inside up the backstretch, altered outside and finished strong to just miss. LOVE TO THE MAX chased the early pace from the inside, remained a forward factor entering the second turn but could not keep pace. COYOTESHIGHESTCALL well placed from the inside, made a bid but was too late. SOUTHERN TRIESTE broke well from the outside to set the early pace and tired. TOYMAKER went evenly. TRIPPED OVER chased the early pace outside and tired. BLUES IN THE NIGHT was outrun.
