**Footnotes**

OPEN CAREFULLY vied two wide around the first turn, took the lead nearing the half-mile pole, drew clear and angled to the rail soon after, widened around the far turn and held clear under a drive in the lane. NICK'S BLITZ disputed the pace inside the the winner around the first turn, settled back inside down the backstretch, chased inside around the far turn and finished willingly to preserve the place. CHRIS'S SYMPHONY lacked speed along the rail, advanced four wide around the far turn and rallied outside to gain the show. SIR FIT'S TOO MUCH chased the pace two and three wide, continued on his left lead in the lane and came up empty. SHINY BLUE lacked speed inside, advanced two wide around the far turn and flattened out in the lane. NARROW BACK failed to menace while racing three wide. ITALIAN GUY saved ground early, raced four wide around the far turn and was not a threat. FOXFIELD DRIVE stalked the pace four wide and tired around the far turn. EL BARRON chased the pace three wide and tired after a half. BAD AS IN GOOD was outrun while racing three and four wide.
