Footnotes

SUGARPLUMFAIRY rated close to the early pace three wide, contested the turn two deep, was carried outward entering the stretch but dug in to quickly regain momentum and inched ahead the final strides. SECOND MARKET rated a short lead inside, contested the rail rounding the turn, dueled clear while losing ground entering the stretch, was caught late and grudgingly ceded the final strides. FAVORITE PRINCESS chased the pace inside and just lasted in show. DIZZY LIZZY chased the early pace from the outside, entered the lane in the five path, finished well and just missed show. SUMMER WIND BLUES gave distant chase from the outside, came through the turn widest, entered the lane in the seven path and finished well. DOUBLEDOWN DIVA chased the pace off the rail, came through the turn three wide then weakened in the lane. LUNAR LAW gave distant chase inside with little improvement. PRINCESS BEAR, briefly close, faded toward the turn. AVELLANA gave chase two deep then faded rounding the turn. TENDER ECHOS was unprepared at the break and displayed no speed.
